Talking about clusters...

➤ In Europe cluster organisations bring together a number of members in a network,

research institutes, universities, large companies, small and medium enterprises (SMEs)...

in a certain geographic territory and working in a specific field (economic sector)

Main objectives:

- bring stakeholders from the same territory and related sectors together for synergies
- support their members' collaboration activity, notably research, development & innovation (RDI) and internationalisation activities

One example on blue growth: EUR 4.1 Mio, 7 European countries, 12 partners including 8 clusters, 75% budget to high impact SMEs' projects





Objective: >100 SMEs for > 40 Blue Growth solutions




International dimension Priority Target Markets by European clusters



International cluster matchmaking events

10 Matchmaking events (2016-2017)

- 2180 bilateral meetings
- 300 participants from Europe
- 140 participants from countries beyond Europe
- 416 cluster cooperation agreements/partnerships initiated or already established
- 28 European countries were represented
- 6 non-European countries represented (including the USA, Taiwan, Brazil, Mexico, Iran and Thailand)

Each Partnership include on average



EU 'Clusters Go International' Partnerships (2018-2019) Overview


Sectoral and Industrial Focus




European Strategic Cluster Partnerships – Going International (ESCP-4i)

- results from First generation (2016-2017)
- 15 co-funded European Strategic Cluster Partnerships involving about 100 cluster organisations across 23 European countries have developed and implemented joint strategies to support SME internationalisation towards third countries (2016-2017)
- 2000 SMEs have been involved in activities targeting international thirdmarkets generating 85 concrete business cooperation cases with international partners
- 370 Cluster-to-Cluster events
- 3010 Business-to-Business events have been conducted
- 39 Memoranda of Understanding (MoU) and 45 collaboration projects implemented between EU clusters and international peer organisations




Cluster cooperation cases (phase 1 and phase 2)
